# Posing Attire and Use of Cosmetics

Similarly to the Rule Book, posing outfits may have embroidery, stripes or other embellishments. For females, bottoms must be tasteful in size and coverage, and will be at the final discretion of the judges, as will all suits.

- Jewelry (bracelets and earrings) may be worn by females with a few guidelines in place. Bracelets should not be more than 2" in thickness and earrings are to not be longer than 2" in length and must be tasteful. Jewelry will also be approved at athlete registration prior to pre-judging by the judges or sport coordinator. It may be beneficial to bring a few options.
- Any permanent jewelry (Dermal piercings) may be worn by both males and females. Eve glasses will be permitted on stage.

#### Pump-up areas/Changerooms

There will be a men's change room and a women's change room and the use of washrooms nearby for both. Both change rooms will be equipped with mirrors. There will also be a few free weights for "pump-up".

- The women's change room will be equipped with the following dumbbell sets: 10lbs, 12.5lbs and 15 lbs as well as 2 resistance bands.
- The men's change room will be equipped with the following dumbbell sets: 15lbs, 20lbs, 25 bs, and 30lbs as well as 2 resistance bands.

#### Tanning and Hair/Make-Up

Tanning on site will be offered by OrganicTan Winnipeg and be at the cost of the competitor.

## **Competition Tanning Tips**

- For best results, spend the week prior to your competition moisturizing your body using an oil-free moisturizer.
- The day before your competition tan, exfoliate and remove unwanted body hair by shaving or waxing. If you prefer waxing/sugaring over shaving please do so 48-72 hours prior.
- While exfoliating, pay special attention to the knees, elbows, hands, feet and heels. The better condition your skin is in, the better the tanning solution will absorb and the more flawless your tan will look.
- Do not use any oil-based scrubs as these will negatively impact on your competition tan.
- Ensure your skin is FREE of ANY product, such as: makeup, deodorant, lotions, moisturizers, perfumes or sprays. These products can create a barrier against the tan developing properly.
- This is very important! Wear loose, dark clothing to and from your tanning appointment to minimize contact with your skin. MUST wear clothing to bed to avoid touching yourself and creating smudges.
- It is best to wear flip flops on your feet no socks or shoes.
- Take extra care when using the bathroom and near water. If you experience any smudges we will correct it at the show!
