Practice

There will be practice lanes available for WPFGB competitors on Sunday July 30, from 12:00 - 16:00, at a flat rate of \$12.00 per person for regardless of the length of time you want to bowl. The lanes will be dressed with the oil pattern that will be used for competition.

- Athletes must call ahead by **July 29th** to make reservations (204) 667-1550 or info@chateaulanes.ca.
- Athletes must show accreditation to participate.
- All payment methods are accepted. These lanes will be dressed with the same oil pattern that will be used for the entire competition.

Competition Schedule

Day 1 + 2 Mornings: Singles

Day 1 + 2 Afternoons: Doubles

Day 3 : Teams + Roll Offs Stepladder **involving top (5) competitors from the All-Events competition.**

Morning Sessions will begin at 8am, with check in beginning at 7am.

Afternoon sessions will begin at 1pm, with check in beginning at 12pm.

Chateau Lanes has a fairly large supply of “House Balls” and rental shoes available for those who are not planning to bring their own bowling equipment to the competition. Shoe rental will cost \$9.00 for the entire 3 days of the competition (including practice day on Sunday).

Equipment Storage

A storage area for bags will be available for athletes. Please ensure your bag has a tag with your name and identification number.

Additional Sport Information

The oil pattern that is being used for the duration of the competition is from Kegel, and is called “ABT # 2”. You can find more details about this oil pattern by going to www.kegel.net and searching for this lane pattern.

All competitors must adhere to the following dress code:

- Dress or casual Slacks/Pants (including Jeans) are permissible, as are dress or casual walking shorts, and skorts.
- All shirts must have sleeves.
- Sweat pants, muscle shirts, cut-offs, tank-tops or hats are not to be worn during competition.
