All the athletes are required to bring:

- 1) Mouthpiece

- 2) Trunks: Fitted Boxing trunks required and provided by the competitor.
- 3) Boxing or Wrestling shoes: **NO EXCEPTIONS**
- 4) Sleeveless jersey: Boxers will require one blue and one red singlet
- 5) Hand wraps: Bandages must not be longer than 4.5m and not shorter than 2.5m, 5.7 cm wide.
- 6) Groin Protectors for Males: Mandatory

### **Additional Sport Information**

Please make sure you have submitted the "Report of Physical Examination" form through Fuse Sport and also carry it with you. You will not be allowed to compete without a Report of Physical Examination (**Doctors will not be available at the venue for Medical Examination**).

### **Competitor's Record Book**

It is mandatory for all the athletes to provide a Competitor's record Book prior to the competition. Every boxer has to register with their country even if it is their first bout. They can go to their local club and register there once they have registered they will receive their record book. Contact your local club to ensure that you have the latest version
