Competition Schedule

All cycling events will begin at 10am.

Sport Equipment

Please note: competitors are required to provide their own bikes for competition. Bikes rentals are in short supply in Winnipeg and surrounding areas.

Riders must wear a securely fastened helmet, fully enclosed footwear, and the appropriate attire including a shirt. Only multi-gear racing bikes will be allowed in all events.

Each athlete will receive a timing chip. You must return that chip following your race. Volunteers will be present to help in this process.

Additional Sport Information

As the Host Society, we have the ability to transport bikes via trailers. There are a total of 50 spaces available for bikes. Trailers will be aligned with the bus schedule to the venue. Athletes are responsible for fastening and securing their own bike. There will be volunteers to assist if needed. There is limited space available so this service will be on a first come first serve basis. country, and agency if you wish to use this service. Inputting this criteria is essential for the Host to arrange bike transportation. If there is no space on the trailer, we will let you know ASAP.

Sport Specific Information for Cycling (Street)

Criterion

The time length of the race will vary depending on the athletes' age categories.

Age Category	Distances
Men 18+, 30+, 35+	45 minutes plus 3 laps
Men 40+, 45+	40 minutes plus 3 laps
Men 50+, 55+	35 minutes plus 3 laps
Men 60+, 65+, 70+, 75+, and all Womens categories	30 minutes plus 3 laps

Sprint

The length of the course will be 800m.

There will be ample time for athletes to rest between each of their three heats.

Time Trials

The length of the course is 11.1km. All athletes will complete two full laps around the course totalling 22.2km.

Road Race

The length of the race will vary depending on your age category. One lap around the course is 11.1km.

You must bring your department / agency identification when checking in at the accreditation centre.
