Sport Equipment

- Teams must bring their own warm up balls, game balls will be provided for competition only.
- All players are required to wear protective gloves, suitable boots or shoes, and a
 protective helmet equipped with a facemask and a chinstrap which must be properly
 fastened on both sides. In addition, the designated goalkeeper shall wear a throat
 quard, a chest protector and a box/cup.
- Teams shall have two sets of jerseys of contrasting colors.
