Competition Schedule

Sport Equipment

- Teams can choose to use their own footballs as long as it is approved by the referees and both teams. WPFG will provide game balls if teams can't agree on their own ball.
- Teams will be required to bring their own practice balls.
- Please ensure you have proper footwear to play on turf and grass. Metal cleats are
 NOT permitted on the venue.
- No hard padding equipment (such as shoulder pads, hip pads, thigh pads or helmets)
 may be worn. Soft knee pads may be worn on the knees only. Softball sliding pads,
 sweatbands and headbands may be worn. Hand or arm pads are prohibited.
- Opposing team's jerseys must be contrasting colors. The home team (first listed on schedule) must adjust if there is a conflict. Jerseys must be numbered individually.





Additional Sport Information

A game must start with 8 players and may continue with 6 players, but not with 5 or less. Each team will designate a player as field captain and only he/she may communicate with officials.

Transportation

As part of your Accreditation, you will be granted free access to <u>Winnipeg Transit</u> services, which is perfect for getting around to different attractions throughout the city as well as the majority of our competition venues. WPFG will provide a dedicated Athlete Bus which will depart from the RBC Convention Centre Transportation Hub. Please visit the Transportation Information Desk located at the front entrance of the RBC Convention Centre for your detailed schedule prior to competition.

Parking

There is a limited amount of free parking at the Maple Grove Mustangs Club on venue. Parking on the roadside inside the park is not permitted. Please use the provided Athletes Bus whenever possible.

Registration in Winnipeg

All competitors are REQUIRED to register at the RBC Convention Centre Accreditation Centre and receive their credentials no later than the day before their competition begins. Competitors are also required to bring those credentials to the field of play each day of competition for check-in.

You must bring your department / agency Identification when checking in at the accreditation centre.
