We advise all athletes to bring your own pucks for warmups. Each team will be provided 10 for the tournament.

Personal equipment must be supplied by the competitors and will comply with the safety requirements as specified in the IIHF (or national/state affiliate) rule book. Half or full coverage masks are mandatory for all players.

Equipment Storage





Due to the number of teams we are now able to offer Hockey bag storage at the competition venues. Hockey bag storage will be available for athletes competing at both Seven Oaks Arena & the Hockey For All Centre, details below:

Seven Oaks: It is recommended for teams competing at Seven Oaks to bring a lock to secure their equipment.

Hockey For All: There will be no security on site at Hockey For All so equipment must be left at their own risk.

Additional Sport Information

Body Checking is not permitted in any division. Fighting has a no tolerance policy. Athletes will be suspended if they are involved in a fight.
