Sport Equipment

The following protective equipment is compulsory:

- A. WKF approved mitts, one Competitor wearing red and the other wearing blue.
- B. Gum shield
- C. WKF approved body protector (respectively male and female design as applicable)
- D. WKF approved shin pads, one Competitor wearing red and the other wearing blue
- E. WKF approved foot protection, one Competitor wearing red and the other wearing blue
- F. WKF approved groin guards for men
- G. WKF approved red and blue embroidered karate-gi and red and blue belts.

Please make sure that you have submitted your **Medical Release Form** through Fuse Sport, and also carry it with you. You will not be allowed to compete without a medical certificate **(Doctors will not be available at the venue for Medical Examination)**.
