Practice

There will be a practice day on **Sunday July 30, 2023**, at the Winnipeg Trap and Skeet Club. The practice will be held between **10:00 and 16:00** for all disciplines of Shotgun.

Competition Schedule

The competition will run from 09:00 - 17:00 daily. Your daily schedule breakdown is as follows:

August 2: Trap 16 and Trap 22

August 3: Trap Doubles followed by all shoot offs.

Sport Equipment

Ammunition purchase will be available on venue through Debit or Credit card.

Equipment Storage

RBC Convention Centre (375 York Avenue, Winnipeg) will have supervised, secured and staffed firearms storage (room 2G) for the duration of the event. Storage will be free of charge for the athletes competing in Trap. Storage will be open July 26 until August 7, 2023.

On the day of the competition, athletes will pick up their firearms and ammunition from the storage facility and be transported to the venue. Upon return, athletes will once again secure their firearms and any remaining ammunition in the lockup until they depart Winnipeg. 2023 WPFG Host Society will not be transporting a firearm on behalf of an athlete.





Storage will be under 24/7 armed security. Athlete's accreditation or Passport AND Non-Resident Firearm Declaration Form (RCMP5589) or Canadian PAL (Possession and Acquisition License) will serve as the documents accepted to drop off/pick up firearms at the storage.

Additional Sport Information

Please review the events you have entered, particularly the All Trap and High Overall. If you have not registered and paid for those events, you are not eligible to win that event.

- Athletes are required to bring their ATA/NSSA/ISSF Classification cards.
- Team Captains, please confirm all your members are registered correctly.
- Teams that currently have less than five members need to finalize their additions during the practice day on Sunday. No changes will be allowed after that time you may only team with other countries after there is no one available from your country.

Venue

Winnipeg Trap and Skeet Club Boundary Commission Trail, Oak Bluff, MB

Transportation

As this venue is located outside the Winnipeg Transit footprint, WPFG will provide a dedicated Athlete Bus which will depart from the RBC Convention Centre Transportation Hub. There is a limited amount of free parking at Winnipeg Trap and Skeet, please use the shuttle provided whenever possible.

You must bring your department / agency Identification when checking in at the accreditation centre.
