Practice

The Pan Am Pool will be available to athletes on July 29th for practice purposes. Admission is free on this day with athletes accreditation in addition to a 25 cent locker fee.

A single admission prior to July 29th costs \$7.51 CAD in addition to a 25 cent locker fee.

Sport Equipment

Race kits, which include swim caps, bibs, and tags will be provided for athletes at the pre competition meeting/race kit pickup. Numbers on the swim caps and bibs will be designated to athletes based on their age categories.

*Please note: competitors are required to provide their own bikes for competition. Bike rentals are in short supply in Winnipeg and surrounding areas.

Water and race day snacks will be available for athletes, however, we still recommend athletes bring their own race day snacks and hydration.

Water temperatures will dictate wetsuit usage for athletes:

- Wetsuits are mandatory if water temperature is below 60.6 degrees Fahrenheit (15.9 degrees celsius). When mandatory, the wetsuit must cover at least the torso
- Wetsuits are not permitted if water temperature is above 71.6 degrees Fahrenheit (above 22 degrees celsius)

Additional Sport Information

As the Host Society, we have the ability to transport bikes via trailers. There are a total of 50 spaces available for bikes. As there is limited space available so this service will be on a first come first serve basis. Please email **triathlon@wpfg2023.com** with the subject line **Cycling Trailer**, and in the email include your name, your home country, phone number, and your agency if you wish to use this service. If there is no space on the trailer, we will let you know ASAP.

Loading of the trailer will begin at 7pm and end at 9pm August 2nd, at the Transportation Hub located at the RBC Convention Centre. **This will be your only opportunity to load your bike on the trailer.**

Each athlete is responsible for fastening and securing their bike. There will be volunteers to assist if needed. The trailer will leave downtown Winnipeg and arrive well before the athlete bus to ensure an efficient race day.





Course Information

The biking phase is an out and back for a total of 40 km. All turns will be marshalled. Athletes will exit the park West on Grotte Avenue, turn north (right) on Rue St. Malo, then go west on Bourgeois Avenue. Then, athletes will go south on 218 until you come to the 20km turnaround.

Please review this <u>link</u> regarding frequently violated rules of a triathlon. A few other factors to note is that if winds reach 50 km/h or above, disc wheels are prohibited.

If athletes are competing in the team event, the timing apparatus used will be passed off to the next teammate in each discipline. Please ensure this action happens as there will be no way to document time otherwise.

Athletes competing in the heavyweight division will be weighed at the venue.

Below is a map of the swim, bike, and run course respectively.








ST MALO PROVINCIAL PARK

TRIATHLON - SWIM ROUTE

















ST MALO PROVINCIAL PARK

Venue

St. Malo Provincial Park De La Grotte Ave, St. Malo, MB

Transportation

As part of your Accreditation, you will be granted free access to <u>Winnipeg Transit</u> services, which is perfect for getting around to different attractions throughout the city as well as the majority of our competition venues. As this venue is located outside the Winnipeg Transit footprint, WPFG will provide a dedicated Athlete Bus which will depart from the RBC Convention Centre Transportation Hub. Parking

Park passes will be made available at no cost for athletes who choose to drive to St. Malo Provincial Park.
