Pre Competition Meeting

The Pre competition meeting will act as a practice day so that athletes (and volunteers) can familiarise themselves with the processes of the competition.

Competition Schedule

Below is a tentative schedule: Wednesday, August 2: Individual Competition 10:00 - 17:00 Thursday, August 3: Team Competition 10:00 - 17:00

Individual competition will start by age category in ascending order. Athletes in the 18+ age category will compete first. After each athlete in this category completes their competition, athletes in the 30+ age category will compete and so on.

Sport Equipment

Athletes are expected to bring a turnout jacket, unmodified, and NFPA 1971 or other nationally certified standards on a protective ensemble for Structural Fire Fighting. Helmets must be nationally certified STRUCTURAL Firefighting entry helmets. If your turnout jacket does not meet these requirements, one will be provided for you. Shorts and running shoes are highly recommended for athletes to wear during their competition.

Gloves are mandatory in this competition.

We highly recommend that athletes bring a towel to wet and use to cool down if temperatures are high.

Transportation

As part of your Accreditation, you will be granted free access to <u>Winnipeg city transit</u> services, which is perfect for getting around to different attractions throughout the city as well as the majority of our competition venues. Memorial Park is centrally located in downtown Winnipeg, within walking distance of many WPFG partner hotels.

Parking

There is no available parking at Memorial Park. There is paid street parking available around Memorial Boulevard. Please utilize Winnipeg Transit for your arrival and departure whenever possible.

Registration in Winnipeg

All competitors are REQUIRED to register at the RBC Convention Centre Accreditation Centre and receive their credentials no later than the day before their competition begins.



You must bring your department / agency Identification when checking in at the accreditation centre.

The Opening Ceremony begins with the Athletes Parade, which will start at the **RBC Convention Centre, 3rd Floor HALL A/B** and march to the **Canada Life Centre** (approx. 600 meters). Food & Beverage will be available for purchase in the marshalling area. You must have your Accreditation to access Hall A/B and take part in the parade.

*Things to Note:

- Only Athlete credentials will be permitted into the marshalling area or into the Athlete Parade at any point.
- The Accreditation Centre closes at 4:00pm on July 28.
- Please do not bring bags to the Opening Ceremony or Athlete Marshalling Area.

The opening ceremony is the official kick off to the 2023 World Police and Fire Games and will welcome athletes to Winnipeg with an exciting event in Canada Life Centre. Please ensure you RSVP attendance through your registration profile on <u>Fuse Sport</u>. Please note, your plus one pass will not be seated with parade and ceremony participants.
